## ARTICLES I Can Do It Myself!

Can you picture the 4 year-old declaring this as he tries to tighten a screw in your kitchen cabinet?

Can you picture the 15 year-old declaring this as he jumps behind the steering wheel of your car?

Can you picture the 24 year-old declaring this as he fills out his taxes for the first time?

It's easy for us to look at others and think how foolish they are to think they can do these things on their own. Maybe they can, but we wonder why they don't want some help.

No doubt some will quiver in the corner, hoping someone else will take on the task in front of them... doing the math homework, finding a job, getting out of debt, or fixing the car... But, most of us will, at least at times, go it alone.

## Can you picture yourself declaring "I can do it myself!"?

Maybe you aren't that obvious about it, but we really do approach much of life with that attitude. Consider your week. What have you done?

The list probably includes many things you do every week... eat, dress, drive, work, parent. You know you can do these things without help. So, we silently chant, "I can do it myself!"

As many of you know, I had hernia surgery last week. Recovery was great the first day. I charted the medications they gave me and when I took each one. I timed the ones that made me sleepy for bed time, but then needed more during the day. Not long after that I reduced meds so I would not be sleepy. Eventually, Steph intervened and started charting for me and making recommendations. That helped, but by Friday I figured I could handle the pain and stopped taking anything. As those at camp know, I was miserable on Saturday.

Now circle all the "I"s above. See the problem.

Jesus actually said...

*"I can do nothing on my own. As I hear, I judge, and my judgment is just, because I seek not my own will but the will of him who sent me." John 5:30 ESV* 

Jesus sought the will of the Father. He looked for what the Father was doing (John 5:19) and joined him. So, enough of this "I can do it myself!" It is time we take some long pauses to consider what God's will is for us.

### Here are some practical steps to take:
