Sermon Notes: Why We Do. What We Do.

Key Scriptures: 1 Corinthians 12:31-13:13

...it is not "love versus the gifts" that Paul has in mind, but "love as the only context for gifts"; for without the former, the latter have no usefulness at all - but then neither does anything else in the Christian life. -Gordon Fee

Paul's Checklist of Love (verses 4-5) – What our hearts should look like on the inside, and our actions on the outside.

1. Love is Patient - *makrothyméō* ("showing divinely-directed patience") is "longsuffering" because it only expresses anger *as the Lord directs* (i.e. is the opposite of being "quick-tempered").

2. Love is Kind - *chréstos* - to show oneself mild, to be kind, use kindness; (full of service to others), gentle.

3. It does not envy - $z\bar{e}/d\bar{o}$ – properly, to bubble over because *so hot* (*boiling*); (figuratively) "to burn with zeal";...absolutely, to be heated or to boil...with envy, hatred, anger *4. God determines what gifts we receive.*

4. It does not boast - *perpereúomai* (from *perperos*, "a braggart") – to act as a braggart, i.e. a "show off" who needs too much attention.

5. It is not proud - *physióō* – properly, inflate by blowing; (figuratively) swelled up, like an egotistical person spuing out arrogant ("puffed-up") thoughts.

6. It is not rude - *asxēmonéō* – to act unseemly (literally, "improperly"); (figuratively) to lack proper form and hence thought of as unseemly (indecent, unbecoming).

7. It is not self-seeking - zētei - to seek to further the profit or advantage of one.

8. It is not easily angered - *paroksýnō* - to irritate, provoke, rouse to anger.

9. It keeps no record of wrongs - *logízomai* (the root of the English terms "*logic, logical*") – properly, *compute*, "take into account"; *reckon* (come to a "bottom-line")

Kakon - what is contrary to law, either divine or human, wrong, crime...

God doesn't want us to love others, so they'll love us. He wants us to love others, so they'll love Him. - Pastor Doug

Application:

- 1. Memorize or write down verses 4 & 5 to keep with you as a reminder of God's desire for our motives and actions.
- 2. Spend time this week in prayer with this list. Thank God for where He has helped you to do well, and ask God to help you in areas where you struggle.
- 3. Be patient. Remember that just by being patient your motives and actions will typically be more loving in a God glorifying manner.
- 4. Remember that even if you don't "feel like" doing the action, the right motive always boils down to wanting to obey God. Motives aren't thoughts and feelings, they're why we're doing what we're doing.
