18 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

### **Chapter 12**

Ephesians 2:8-10 New International Version (NIV)  
8 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—  
and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— 9  
not by works, so that no one can boast. 10 For we are  
God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good  
works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

### **Chapter 13**

Romans 8:15-16 New International Version (NIV)

15 The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship.[a] And by him we cry, "Abba,[b] Father." 16 The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children.

### **Chapter 14**

Ephesians 5:18-20 New International Version (NIV)

18 Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit, 19 speaking to one another with psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit. ### **Chapter 22**

Ephesians 6:14-18 New International Version (NIV)

<sup>14</sup> Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, <sup>15</sup> and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. <sup>16</sup> In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. <sup>17</sup> Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.
