

Sermon Notes: Shed Some Weight

Key Scriptures: Hebrews 12:1-3 & Romans 6:11-14

Hebrews 12:1 - "let us lay aside every **weight**, and the **sin** which so easily ensnares *us*, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,"

<u>WEIGHTS:</u>

1 Corinthians 10:23 - "I have the right to do anything," you say—but not everything is beneficial. "I have the right to do anything"—but not everything is constructive.

<u>SIN:</u>

Romans 6:12-13 - 12 Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires. 13 Do not offer any part of yourself to sin as an instrument of wickedness, but rather offer yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life; and offer every part of yourself to him as an instrument of righteousness.

- 1. What are the weights and/or sins in your life hindering your walk with God, or ensnaring you?
- 2. Which one's can you do something about?
- 3. What are you gonna do about it?
