

Key Scriptures: John 13:34-35, John 15:12-13, Proverbs 3:11-12, Matthew 5:43-48, & Romans 5:8-10

**John 13:34-35** - 34 A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. 35 By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

#### Sacrificially

**John 15:12-13** - 12 My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. 13 Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends.

#### With Discipline
