

#### STEP 3. Determine Your Vehicle.

Sometimes the bus will be the perfect vehicle to get you to your next milestone, but you can't get to the destination on the bus alone or a bike alone. You will want a garage full of options. Maybe there is a course that would be ideal to do with your family or maybe with a men's group or maybe just as a private study. Consider which vehicle you need now and who should be in that vehicle with you. Who will you ask to join you? You don't have to wait for the church to start your vehicle, but we are happy to help.



### STEP 4. Fill Your Fuel Tank.

You can have a destination, a path and a vehicle ready to go, but without fuel you won't get anywhere. God's Word and God's Spirit are the fuel we need. The courses and milestones will help you, but they depend on you hearing from God through his Word and Spirit. If you are not sure about this step, watch <u>The Divine Mentor</u>. Now is the time to initiate new spiritual habits of prayer, Bible reading, learning from these courses, discussing it with others and journaling.

### STEP 5. Consider your speed.

You can go fast or you can go slow, but you'll want to make the most of your time with those in your vehicle. To go fast a bike might be ideal for some courses, but you'll still want to process what you are learning with someone. Most courses are designed to go slower with a group. Many have small group leader and participant books which may be very helpful. At the very least, you are urged to be asking these questions as you work through each course.

- 1. What are you hearing from God?
- 2. What does God want you to do?
- 3. How can we pray for you?

## Why should you jump on the path?

It's not complicated. God wants you to be mature. *Therefore, let us leave the elementary teachings about Christ and go on to maturity... (Heb. 6:1)* God also wants us to pursue maturity with diligence and intentionality.

For physical training is of some value, but godliness has value for all things, holding promise for both the present life and the life to come. That is why we labor and strive, because we have put our hope in the living God, who is the Savior of all people, and especially of those who believe... Persevere in them, because if you do, you will save both vourself and vour hearers. (1 Tim. 4:8-10,15-16)


