Sermon Notes: Idolatry, Attitude, and Influence

Key Scriptures: 1 Corinthians 8:1-11:1

The problem (here) is primarily attitudinal. They think Christian conduct is predicated on ("knowledge") and that knowledge gives them ("rights/freedom) to act as they wish in this matter. Paul has another view: The content of their knowledge is only partially correct; but more importantly, (knowledge) is not the primary ground of Christian behavior...("love") is...In this case love takes the form of "the stumbling block principle," which does not have to do with "offending" someone but with causing others to fall by urging them to participate in an action they can do only against their own conscience.

1 Corinthians 8:9 - 9 Be careful, however, that the exercise of your rights does not become a stumbling block to the weak.

1 Corinthians 10:31-33 - ³¹ So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God. ³² Give no offense to Jews or to Greeks or to the church of God, ³³ just as I try to please everyone in everything I do, not seeking my own advantage, but that of many, that they may be saved.
