# Re-forming Me

Sermon Notes: Body and Spirit United Key Scriptures: 1 Corinthians 6:12-20

Apparently some men within the Christian community were going to prostitutes and arguing for the right to do so. Being people of the Spirit, they imply, has moved them to a higher plane, the realm of spirit, where they are unaffected by behavior that merely has to do with the body...There is a kind of self-deception that inflated spirituality promotes, which suggests to oneself that one is acting with freedom and authority, but which is in fact an enslavement of the worst kind - to the very freedom someone thinks they have.

Somehow in our minds we come to the place when God reveals His gift of salvation to us, that we see our bodies (the physical) and the spirit as separate, so we believe that what we do in the body doesn't affect the Spirit.

And so we start to justify the sin in our lives because we believe spirit and bodies are separate and since Christ died for my sins, that are covered eternally, that what I do now in the body isn't that big of a deal.
