Sermon Notes: Fruit of the Spirit

Key Scriptures: Ephesians 4:17-30

- **Q:** What does it look like for us to do battle in the flesh?
- **A:** We do battle in the physical realm by walking in obedience.

Ecclesiastes 12:13b - Here now is my final conclusion: Fear God and obey his commands, for this is everyone's duty.

Galatians 5:16-17 -16 So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. 17 For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want.

4 Battles:

- 1. Lies vs. Truth. (Eph. 4:25)
- 2. Bitterness vs. Reconciliation (Eph. 4:26)
- 3. Stealing/Taking vs. Working/Giving (Eph. 4:28)
- 4. Unwholesome Talk/Gossip vs. Wholesome talk/Affirmation. (Eph. 4:29)

Gossip - Saying something negative about someone behind their back. **Affirmation** - Saying something positive directly to someone.

Application:

- **1.** If you've lied to someone, confess and ask for forgiveness.
- 2. If you're holding bitterness towards someone, initiate reconciliation.
- 3. If you're stealing, stop and pay it back. If you're not stealing, give to someone in need this week.
- 4. If you have an issue with someone go to them and talk about it. Otherwise, intentionally go to at least 3 people this week and affirm them.
