#### Greed Will Wreck You: How To Avoid It

#### Luke 12:13-21 (NET 2nd ed.)

13 Then someone from the crowd said to him, "Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me." 14 But Jesus said to him, "Man, who made me a judge or arbitrator between you two?" 15 Then he said to them, "Watch out and guard yourself from all types of greed, because one's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions." 16 He then told them a parable: "The land of a certain rich man produced an abundant crop, 17 so he thought to himself, 'What should I do, for I have nowhere to store my crops?' 18 Then he said, 'I will do this: I will tear down my barns and build bigger ones, and there I will store all my grain and my goods. 19 And I will say to myself, "You have plenty of goods stored up for many years; relax, eat, drink, celebrate!" '20 But God said to him, 'You fool! This very night your life will be demanded back from you, but who will get what you have prepared for yourself?' 21 So it is with the one who stores up riches for himself, but is not rich toward God."

#### More Q & A on Giving...

# Jesus repeatedly calls disciples to give to the poor in the gospels, so should I just give to the food pantry or other organizations that help the poor and skip the church?

Beyond helping the poor, Jesus did instruct his disciples to receive provision from others in Luke 10:7. Later, Paul repeatedly calls the believers to support those who teach in the church (1 Corinthians 9:9-14; 2 Corinthians 11:8; Philippians 4:16-19; 1 Timothy 5:17-18). Our deacons work hard to steward well the funds they receive. They seek to help individuals with needs, to support local organization, international missions, and our local teaching ministry needs. #### What's happening with giving in the USA?

"Only 5% of Americans are tithers. Most (80%) give about 2% of their income to tithing donations. About 3–5% of those who attend and donate to churches do so through tithing. 17% of Americans responded that they tithe regularly. Tithe statistics reveal that most tithers (77%) donate 11–20% of their income. This tithing percentage is much higher than the baseline of 10%. About 70% of tithers base donations on gross income rather than on net income. **Christians these days give 2.5% of their income, which is less than how much they gave in the past.** 

During the Great Depression, they gave a higher share of 3.3%. Only 1% of Households making over \$75,000 contribute with tithing amounts of at least 10% of their income. Christian church charity statistics demonstrate that 17% of American households currently give less than they used to in local church donations. For 7% of regular churchgoers, the amounts donated dropped by 20%." (https://balancingeverything.com/church-giving-statistics/)

#### I'm in debt and can't afford to give, what should I do?

You need to get control of your finances. Dave Ramsey has some great materials on baby steps to get rid of debt. I don't agree with everything he says, but when it comes to Christian teaching on money, he has great stuff. Talk with Doug or I about Financial Peace University.
