### Key Scripture: Daniel 9:1-3 & 20-27

# <u>4 Goals for Today:</u>

- 1. God is outside of space and time and is in control of a plan bigger than any one of us that we cannot see.
- 2. Daniel 9 is a fulfillment of Jeremiah's prophecies.

# Jeremiah 25:8-12

### Jeremiah 29:10-12

3. Daniel 9 predicts the triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, and his death on the cross.

### Daniel 9:25-26

4. Luke 19 - Jesus wept over the city of Jerusalem because His people did not recognize the time of his coming, which was predicted for them in Daniel 9.

### Luke 19:41-44

- 1. Ask yourself this question: Are you so busy "doing things for" Jesus that you don't actually recognize Him when He's right in front of you?
- 2. Dig into the word and find some treasure. Read Jeremiah 25 and 29, then Daniel 9, and then Luke 19:28-44

#### Who May Participate In Communion?

"We welcome all those who are displeased with themselves because of their sins, but who nevertheless trust that their sins are pardoned and that their remaining weakness is covered by the suffering and death of Christ, and who also desire more and more to strengthen their faith and to lead a better life. Hypocrites and those who are unrepentant, however, eat and drink judgment on themselves." (Heidelberg Catechism Q&A 81; 1 Cor. 10:19-22; 11:26-32)

Paul challenges believers to participate in communion in a manner that is sincere and authentic. He writes to the church in Corinth..."Eat the bread or drink the cup of the Lord in the right way. Don't do it in a way that isn't worthy of him. If you do, you will be guilty. You'll be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord. Everyone should take a careful look at themselves before they eat the bread and drink from the cup." (1 Cor. 11:27-28 NIRV)

So, we welcome any who are trusting in Jesus to forgive their sins to participate in the Lord's Supper. If your child understands the above statement, they too are welcome to the table. As well we want to urge those who trust Jesus to join with us in ministry as active confessing members. Check out "Discovering Membership" online or at the information table.
