

Heartsaver First Aid and Adult CPR/AED Heartsaver® First Aid and Adult CPR AED is a classroom, video-based, instructor-led course that teaches students critical skills needed to respond to and manage a first aid, choking or sudden cardiac arrest emergency in the first few minutes until emergency medical services (EMS) arrives. Students learn skills such as how to treat bleeding, sprains, broken bones, shock, and other first aid emergencies. This course also teaches adult CPR and AED use. Training Date: Sat, Jan 12th at 8am-12pm at Alto Reformed Church. Attendance includes a certified instructor, upfront consultation time to clarify training goals and objectives, supplemental materials and handouts to support training outcomes, registration and record keeping of all participants, and evaluation feedback upon conclusion of the training.
