

HOW YOU CAN CHANGE THE WORLD: START MAKING DISCIPLES

A. Pray and identify who you will disciple.

Consider family, friends, church and community. Make a list.

B. ASK the "THREE LIFE CHANGING QUESTIONS."

- 1. What is God saying to you? (As you look at your life, what believers are saying, and what you've read in the Bible...)
- 2. What does He want you to do? (Specifically, what should you do today? Everyday?)
- 3. How can I pray for you? (Then actually pray for them.)

If Jesus can make apostles out of fishermen, he can make an apostle out of you!

APPLICATION: Accept the call to make disciples!

Personal Application

- Make a list of people who have had an influence on your discipleship journey and reflect on how they have impacted your life. Call or write a note to thank them.
- Make a list of people in your life in whom you might invest. Contact one of these people and invite
 them to go for coffee, for a walk, to a baseball game, etc. and seek to get to know them better.
 Begin to intentionally develop a relationship with this person, with your focus being on loving rather
 than "saving" them or "fixing" them.
- Use one of the THREE LIFE CHANGING QUESTIONS with someone this week.

Prayer

- You: Pray for boldness and generosity to begin sharing with someone the things that God entrusted to you.
- Alto: Pray for our church as we begin *Discipleship Essentials*. Pray that God will transform us in a
 relationship with himself, and that we will become disciple-makers. And ask God to raise up a new
 generation of disciple-makers. (Matthew 9:35-38)
- ERC Paramount, CA: Pray for their leadership to have wisdom and courage as they seek to raise
 up 1000 points of light (disciples). Pray for their Compton Initiative to see the Holy Spirit bring
 repentance, racial reconciliation, godly servant leaders, structural change, and a strong police &
 community relationship.
