Popular Scriptures from Zechariah:

4:6 - So he said to me, "This is the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel: 'Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit,' says the Lord Almighty.

4:10a - Do not despise these small beginnings, for the Lord rejoices to see the work begin, to see the plumb line in Zerubbabel's hand."

A rare appearance of Satan in the Old Testament:

3:1 - Then the angel showed me Jeshua the high priest standing before the angel of the Lord. The Accuser, Satan, was there at the angel's right hand, making accusations against Jeshua.

Haggai 1:4 - "Is it a time for you yourselves to be living in your paneled houses, while this house remains a ruin?"

Broad Outline of the Book of Zechariah

First Half (Chapters 1-8)

1. The first 6 verses of the book are like an introduction, and Zechariah is warning the people not to fall into the same patterns of sin their ancestors fell into. 2. Then 1:1-6:15 are 8 different visions that were given to Zechariah 3 months later during 1 night. I don't have the time to dig into the meaning of all of these visions, but as I said a lot of (not all) of the meaning from these visions pertains to the period of time around when Zechariah lived. I encourage you all to watch the videos that are listed on the insert.
3. Next we have 6:8-15 which are instructions the Lord gives to Zechariah about the crowning of Jeshua the high-priest as king. (And we're gonna come back to this)
4. Chapters 7-8 are taking place 2 years later. In the beginning of chapter 7 a group of men comes from Bethel to ask about whether or not they should keep fasting and mourning the temple's destruction; And the remainder of these 2 chapters is a response to their question, Where he ultimately is saying stop mourning and start building!

Second half: Which is basically broken down into 2 sections:

5. Chapters 9-11 Are about Jesus coming and being rejected.
6. Then Chapters 12-14 are about the end times. And if you read through what's gonna happen it's gonna be terrifying, but in the end God will show up and He will fight for His people.

Messianic Prophecy:

- The Branch (Zechariah 3:8 & 6:12)
- Jesus Riding on a Donkey (Zechariah 9:9 & John 12:14-16)
- 30 pieces of silver and the potter's field (Zech. 11:12-13 & Mt. 27:9B-10)
- Scattering of the sheep (Zechariah 13:7 & Mt. 26:31 and 55-56)
- Jesus is a priest forever in the line of Melchizedek (Gen 14:17-20 & Heb. Chpt. 7)
